Accessibility and getting here

Main Entrance

The main entrance is on Union Street.

There is a ramp from street level to the main entrance and all stalls will be on ground floor level.

Parking

Outwith blue badge spaces, the music hall does not have any dedicated parking spaces.

Blue badge spaces are located at Golden Square and South Silver Street.

For health and safety reasons neither Scarf nor APA staff can assist disabled patrons in and out of their transport or mobility equipment.

No Height Restricted Parking

Gallowgate Car Park - 13 min walk Max. 4 hour stay Pay in person only

Summer Street Car Park - 5 min walk Max. 4 hour stay Pay in person only

Golden Square - Directly behind venue Limited parking spaces available

Height Restricted Parking

Aberdeen Car Park - 6 min walk Max. Height 1.98m - Pay in person only

Q-Park Aberdeen Trinity Centre Car Park - 3 min walk Max. Height 1.88m

Public Transport

The Music Hall is conveniently located on Union Street which has stops for many bus routes. It also a short walk from Aberdeen train station.

Times & Registration

The Music Hall will be open for set-up at 8 am. The event will run from 10 am - 4 pm.

Registration will take place at the front entrance. Please be registered and set up by 9.45 am.

First Aid

There are first aid trained staff available onsite. For accidents and emergencies, please alert a member of staff immediately. There is a first aid point at Reception in the foyer.
